February is the Month of the Holy Family.

February 6th is the Feast of St. Paul Miki and Companions (The Holy Martyrs of Japan.) February 7th is the Feast of our Lady of Grace. February 8th is the Feast of St. Josephine Bakhita. The Feast of St. Scholastica is on February 10th. February 11th is the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes (World Day of the Sick) and the Feast of St. Valentine is on February 14. Ordinary Time ends on February 13th. On Ash Wednesday, this year on February 14th, we begin the season of Lent, a time of simplifying oneself and preparing for Easter. It is a time of prayer and reaching out to others and reflecting on what is truly important in our lives.
