Continuous Improvement of Student Learning / Achievement

<u>CCAT Update:</u> Board-Wide Screening will take place in Fall 2024. Students in grade four will be given the Canadian Cognitive Abilities Test, Seventh Edition (CCAT-7), a test of thinking and reasoning skills. Parents will be able to request the results of the CCAT test after Christmas from their school principal. Please contact the school with any questions/concerns.

EQAO Update: The Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO) has released provincial, school- and board-level data from its 2023–2024 assessments, which marks the third consecutive year of the agency's reporting on the student achievement results of its online provincial assessments. EQAO data provide an independent snapshot that shows whether students are meeting curriculum expectations in reading, writing and mathematics at key stages of their education. The results also provide additional insights into students' attitudes and perceptions related to their learning. Our school results will be shared with the staff, parents of students who completed the Spring 2024 EQAO assessments, and the school community in future communication.
