Protecting Youth Information Sessions

YCDSB has recently shared information regarding upcoming sessions that will be hosted by the York Catholic District School Board and the York Regional Police on protecting youth from human trafficking and online child exploitation.

There has been a great deal of interest in the sessions and many parents have asked for students younger than 15 years old to attend. Following consultation with the York Regional Police, they have agreed to do their best to make the presentation appropriate for children as young as 10 years old.

It is important to note that these age ranges are suggestions. Conversations about these topics are difficult and children of various ages will respond differently to this information. You are encouraged to use your unique knowledge of your child to determine if the presentation is right for them.

Continuous Improvement of Student Learning / Achievement

Knowledgehook is a secure, online tool designed to provide useful information to help guide your child in their math learning journey. Getting questions correct is not necessarily the goal but rather to better understand your child's **thinking** and to **identify** areas where they may need more **support**.

As a parent, you can connect to your child's account and be part of supporting that learning. You will receive valuable information via email including the following:

- 1) Receive reports shared by your child's teacher showing activities covered in class so you can see a general overview of how your child is understanding the current questions. (you will note receive the exact questions but see where your child is struggling)
- 2) Cheer on your child's milestones by choosing from the selection of inspirational cheers (e-cards). Sending a cheer is like adding a quick note in your child's lunch box. Your child will see your cheer the next time they log into their Student account.
- 3) Time to connect and practice math through play. Students will have access to multiple choice based questions that you can work through with your child when logged into their student account.
