#### **Inclement Weather Protocol**

- From time to time, it is necessary to cancel student transportation, classes and/or programs due to severe weather. On rare occasions, severe weather makes it necessary to close schools, administrative offices or sites.
- If Environment Canada forecasts poor weather conditions (including ice, significant snowfall, poor visibility, or extreme cold temperatures), the situation will be assessed and monitored overnight and into the early morning in order to determine any necessary bus cancellations.
- This decision will be made by 6:00 AM by the Director of Education.
- Staff will continue to monitor inclement weather impacts on YCDSB students, families, staff, and operations. Adjustments will be made if necessary.

**<u>Celebrating Advent in our Catholic Schools</u>:** This year the season of Advent begins on Sunday, December 1st. As Catholics, we also mark the start of a new liturgical year, Year C, in our 3-year liturgical cycle. Advent is a season of joyful waiting, a time of hope when we anticipate the arrival of the Christ Child who comes into our lives each day and who will come again in Glory. During Advent, we prepare our hearts and minds for the arrival of Christmas when we celebrate the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem over 2000 years ago.

The Liturgical colours of Advent are not the red and green of the secular Christmas decorations but a beautiful purple and a joyful pink. Prayer centres may feature an Advent Wreath and signs and symbols of the Nativity. Electronic candles, honouring Advent as the season of light, are also appropriate. A <u>Jesse tree</u> is another way to learn more about the ancestry of Jesus, Prince of Peace.
