Reporting Student Absences/Lates/Illness

Please continue to use our Safe Arrival System to report absences and lates. Before bell time for the current day, please call 1-855-856-7862 or online at: go/schoolmessenger.ca. As well, the SchoolMessenger App (blue icon) from the Apple App Store or Google Play store.

Students are strongly encouraged to arrive on time. Should your child arrive late, please use the entrance buzzer and a staff member will instruct you when to enter. **Students arriving after the bell will be asked to be signed in at the office by parents/guardians**. Please have a pick-up plan in place in the event that your child is not feeling well and needs to be picked up. (see attached information card) LINK

<u>Kiss'n Ride</u>

If your child must be driven to school, here are the guidelines we would like everyone to abide by. · Please <u>do not double park in the school parking lot, we need to ensure a safe flow of</u> <u>traffic, as well as clear sightlines of all pedestrians</u>.

• Enter the Kiss and Ride lane close to the kindergarten play area and put your vehicle in park before allowing your child to get out of the car

Students must independently exit from the right hand side of the car (closest to the school) and parents should remain in the car. Parents may then enter the "drive thru" (left lane) to exit the parking lot. Parents are to leave immediately after drop off to keep the traffic flowing.
 All student belongings (eg. Knapsack) should be inside the car, rather than the trunk for easy access and quick exit

• Parents who prefer to walk their children to their designated yards are asked to park on the street and walk them to the appropriate area. Our best advice is to leave home early and walk if possible.

Parents are reminded to arrive between 3:35 p.m.-3:40 p.m. at the designated areas.

Continuous Improvement of Student Learning / Achievement

The Centre for Education in Mathematics and Computing Math Circles Series (Winter) is a **FREE** enrichment program for students in Grades 6 to 12.
