<u>Active School Travel:</u> Walking to the school bus stop and riding the bus to school are considered important forms of active school travel. Please review the attachment to ensure all members of the school community continue to follow safe practices on and/or around school buses throughout the school year.

<u>Shrove Tuesday:</u> <u>Tuesday, March 4th,</u> is Shrove Tuesday or Pancake Tuesday. Once again this year our Catholic School Council will be supporting our pancake snack for our students. A letter will be sent home with each student. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the office.

<u>Student Safety Reminder</u> As always, student safety is our top priority. With snow removal ongoing around the school, we ask that student walkers use the following designated routes when traveling to and from school:

- 1. The center walkway, located in front of the school.
- 2. The sidewalks on the East side of the school.

Please remember that students should not use the driveway with moving vehicles to access sidewalks. For everyone's safety, it's crucial to follow these guidelines when arriving or leaving the school.

Special Note: Upon dismissal at the end of the day, students are reminded they are **NOT** to be playing on the snow mounds surrounding the school, but instead they are to go directly home.

Reporting Student Absences/Lates/Illness

Please continue to use our Safe Arrival System to report absences and lates. Before bell time for the current day, please call 1-855-856-7862 or online at: go/schoolmessenger.ca. As well, the SchoolMessenger App (blue icon) from the Apple App Store or Google Play store.

Students are strongly encouraged to arrive on time. Should your child arrive late, please use the entrance buzzer and a staff member will instruct you when to enter. **Students arriving after the bell will be asked to be signed in at the office by parents/guardians**. Please have a pick-up plan in place in the event that your child is not feeling well and needs to be picked up. (see attached information card) **LINK**

Kiss'n Ride

If your child must be driven to school, here are the guidelines we would like everyone to abide by.

- · Please do not double park in the school parking lot, we need to ensure a safe flow of traffic, as well as clear sightlines of all pedestrians.
- Enter the Kiss and Ride lane close to the kindergarten play area and put your vehicle in park before allowing your child to get out of the car
- · Students must independently exit from the right hand side of the car (closest to the school) and parents should remain in the car. Parents may then enter the "drive thru" (left lane) to exit the parking lot. Parents are to leave immediately after drop off to keep the traffic flowing.
- · All student belongings (eg. Knapsack) should be **inside the car, rather than the trunk** for easy access and quick exit
- · Parents who prefer to walk their children to their designated yards are asked to park on the street and walk them to the appropriate area. Our best advice is to leave home early and walk if possible.

Dismissal/Pick UP

Parents are reminded to arrive between 3:35 p.m.-3:40 p.m. at the designated areas. **Please do not enter the Bus Loop during this time.**
